## **Exclusion Request Form**

## How do I get out of the Settlement?

If you do not want to be bound by the settlement, you <u>must</u> request to be excluded from the settlement. If you request to be excluded, you will retain any individual rights you have against Safeway or Albertsons Companies, and you will not be deemed to have individually "released" any of the defendants from any of the Released Claims. However, you will <u>not</u> be eligible to receive compensation under the settlement, as described in the Notice. You also may not object to the settlement if you request to be excluded.

Unless you exclude yourself, you give up any right to sue Safeway or Albertsons Companies for the claims that this settlement resolves. If you have a pending lawsuit, speak to your lawyer in that lawsuit to determine whether you must exclude yourself from this settlement to continue your own lawsuit. If you properly exclude yourself from the settlement, you will not be bound by any orders or judgments entered in this case relating to this settlement.

I request that I be excluded from the Settlement Class in the case of *Stewart et al. v. Albertsons Cos.*, *Inc.* I understand that if I am excluded from the class, I will not be bound by anything that happens in this lawsuit.
